I am Rasakumar Sevarani. I live in Chulipuram East with my husband and 2 children. Our elder daughter, Mathusana has a mental illness. She was unable to speak when she was a young child. We have raised her with kindness. By observing her parents and her younger sister, she is slowly attempting to speak and attempting to do some tasks at home.



On account of her inability to speak, she was refused admission to Kaithadi School. With assistance from the AGO we managed to enrol her in a special school. They have managed to teach her to speak a little and we are very pleased to see this.

We have no access to water in our home and it has been difficult to raise my family. Kaveri Kala Manram became aware of our plight and helped install water well with motor. We are very grateful and would like to express our sincere gratitude to Kaveri Kala Manram.

Maheswaran Puvirthika and Maherswaran Puvilan are siblings. They both suffer from a mental illness. Their father is a carpenter and mother stays at home to mind them and do house work. They have 2 other sisters and 2 brothers who are attending school. This family is facing immense difficulty. Puvilan is crippled and unable to walk and is bed bound. Many advised the family to admit him to Kaithadi as a boarder but the family preferred to live together and did not take up this offer.
